Business Meeting of Sept 15th, 2020 by Zoom

The meeting was limited to 40 minutes. We had about a dozen attending.

1) Mike Owens was nominated as Lt. Governor for our district and by Kiwanis rules we had a vote that confirmed our approval of his selection.

2) Gerry proposed that we meet two Tuesdays each month by Zoom for the rest of 2020. Our next meeting on Sept. 29th had already been announced with Tom Mitchell to speak.

3) Reg reported on our financial situation. Obviously we are far short of the usual bank balance because of the loss of the Kar Derby and both bike auctions. Once the \$10,000 we had committed to the East End playground project was deducted, there is very little to work with. Reg and Gerry had some proposals as to what could be left for funding and that included the Learn Not To Burn and Helping Hands but some research must be done to check on the state of those ventures with COVID-19 restrictions. We must bear in mind the possible need for some extraordinary funding for whatever is chosen to replace Kulberg's and People's Marketplace as storage for the bikes and Kar Derby ramp etc.

We must be out of Kulberg's by September 30th (that is much earlier than we had thought before) and the future of the People's building is being considered now by Army/Navy.

4) Fees were set at \$130 for the coming year. We may be inquiring whether Kiwanis International will be giving any relief on dues as a result of the pandemic.
